"Harvest Season: A Time for Growth, Change and Celebration" Sister Kimberly Woodard

September is the ninth month of the year. As the month rolls in, you can feel things shifting. Summer is winding down, the air gets cooler, and you start seeing fields ready for harvest. It's not just about gathering crops; it's a perfect reminder of all the changes and new beginnings happening in our own lives.

This time of year feels like a time to make a fresh start. Kids head back to school, farmers work hard to bring in their crops, and everyone gets a chance to try something new. Just like a farmer trusts the whole process from planting to harvesting, we also go through seasons in life that call for patience and faith.

The Bible talks a lot about sowing and reaping, showing us that what we do today shapes what's ahead whether it's in friendships, goals, or growing in faith.

There's so much good advice in Scripture about harvest:

- Galatians 6:7-9: Keep doing good and don't quit-you'll see the results in time.
- 2 Corinthians 9:6: The more generous you are, the more blessings come your way.
- **Matthew 9:37-38:** We are all invited to help spread hope and love-there's always room for more helpers.
- **Deuteronomy 28:12:** God's ready to bless us when we stick with Him.

- Positive Vibes Only: Hang out with people who lift you up.
 "A cheerful heart is good medicine, but a crushed spirit dries up the bones". Proverbs 17:22
- Take Care of Yourself: Mental health matters. Make time for self-care.

 "What? Know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own? For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's." 1 Corinthians 6:19-20
- Celebrate Your Progress: Look back and appreciate how far you've come.

- **Stay Curious:** Learn something new every day-you never know what will inspire you.

More Words of Encouragement

"The LORD (Yaweh) is My Shepherd: Living and Resting in the Covenant Care of God"

The LORD is my shepherd, I shall not want." Psalm 23:1

Few lines of Scripture bring such comfort as the opening of Psalm 23. David's opening words in this Psalm are among the most cherished in Scripture. Yet, when we pause and consider the original Hebrew, the verse shines with even greater brilliance. David begins not with a generic title for God, but with His covenant name: **Yahweh**.

Unlike a title or role, Yahweh is the personal covenant name of God, revealed to Moses at the burning bush (Exodus 3:14). It speaks of the eternal, self-existent One who was, who is, and who will always be. This is not a distant deity or impersonal force but the God who binds Himself to His people in faithful love. When David declares, "Yahweh is my shepherd," he is proclaiming that the eternal God of covenant grace has taken personal responsibility for his life.

When David proclaims, "Yahweh is my shepherd," he declares something astonishing: the King of the universe stoops to take on the lowly role of a shepherd. In the ancient world, shepherds lived among their flocks, guiding, feeding, and protecting them. To call God "my shepherd" is to confess His personal involvement in every detail of life—His care is not abstract, but intimate and constant. It is also to confess that the Creator Himself bends low to lead His sheep with intimate care and watchfulness. Therefore, the shepherd imagery is no accident.

For Christians, this verse reaches its fulfillment in Jesus Christ, who boldly declared, "I am the good shepherd" (John 10:11), identifying Himself with the Yahweh of Psalm 23. In Him, the believer experiences the same covenantal care David described. Christ knows His sheep by name, walks with them through valleys, and leads them beside still waters. In Christ, Yahweh Himself walks among His people, laying down His life for the sheep. The Shepherd of Psalm 23 is the Savior who knows us by name, leads us through dark valleys, and brings us to eternal pastures. His sacrificial death on the cross proved the ultimate act of shepherding love.

The result of such shepherding is profound: "I shall not want." To live under Yahweh's shepherding is to live without lack. This does not mean a life free of trials, desires, or hardship, but rather a life free of ultimate lack and anchored in the sufficiency of God's presence. With Yahweh as shepherd, the Christian has every essential need supplied...guidance in confusion, provision in scarcity, comfort in fear, and hope in uncertainty. His presence is the answer to our deepest longings.

Lacks nothing essential for life and godliness. His guidance replaces confusion with direction, His provision meets needs before they overwhelm, and His presence turns fear into confidence.

Psalm 23:1 is not mere poetry; it is a declaration of identity and security. To say, "Yahweh is my shepherd," is to rest in the assurance that the eternal God personally tends to His children. For the believer, this truth transforms life's uncertainties into opportunities to trust the Shepherd who never fails. It also calls believers to rest in the sufficiency of God's care, to live in quiet confidence that the One who is eternal and unchanging is also personal and present. To say, "Yahweh is my shepherd," is to stand in the assurance that the covenant God of Scripture is leading us home.

Reflection: Living Under the Shepherd's Care

- **Guidance:** He directs my steps when the path ahead is uncertain.
- **Provision:** He meets my needs before they overwhelm me.
- **Protection:** He defends me in danger and walks with me in fear.
- **Presence:** He is near, even in the valley of shadows.

Rest today in this truth: With Yahweh as your shepherd, you are never abandoned, never overlooked, and never without hope.

OUR PROGRAM

Living Faith School of Theology (LFSoT) offers the following types of Certificates, Diplomas, and Degrees.

AUDIT CERTIFICATE

The Audit Program is for those individuals attending for their own personal spiritual growth. Audit students must attend all lectures and read all text books. Audit students will receive a Certificate of Attendance for each 30-credit hour program completed. Audit students may later convert their audit credit to an academic degree credit by completing additional work requirements (tests, papers, and labs) and paying the additional tuition for the degree program.

DIPLOMA PROGRAM

A Diploma in Biblical Studies is awarded to students who successfully completes their designated first-year program for academic credit (30 credit-hours total).

ASSOCIATES DEGREE PROGRAM

An Associates Degree in Biblical Studies is awarded to students who successfully completes their designated second year program for academic credit (60 credit-hours total).

ADVANCED ASSOCIATES DEGREE

An advanced Associates Degree in Biblical Studies is awarded to students who successfully complete their designated third-year program for academic credit (90 credithours total)

BACHELORS DEGREE

A Bachelors Degree in Biblical Studies is awarded to students who successfully completes their designated fourth-year program for academic credit (120 credit-hours total).
